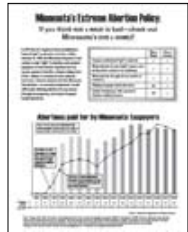

Wesley J. Smith

Smith, an expert on euthanasia, writes about stem cell research, cloning and biotechnology. How are we to avoid a dark future of eugenics-dominated science?

Wesley J. Smith

Smith, an attorney for the International Anti-Euthanasia Task Force, shows readers that America is becoming a country in which life isn't valued and the medically vulnerable are seen as having not just a "right" but a "duty" to die.

Beckwith has written arguably the best comprehensive philosophical defense of the pro-life position ever published. Pro-choice thinkers are thoroughly refuted as the author makes a case for human inclusiveness.

William Brennan

Sociology professor Brennan explores the relationship between demeaning words used to categorize groups of people and actions that result once these words are popularized and accepted. Modern depictions of the unborn and disabled are compared to historical examples of words used against women, Jews, blacks, Soviet peasants and Native Americans.

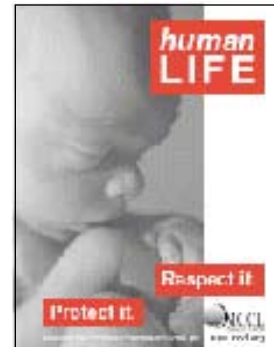
